Improvements and vital repairs to the A6070 link near Carnforth are progressing well. The next stage will see improvement works starting on the bridges.



To undertake these essential activities, it will be necessary to have some road closures. Road closures will only be utilised where it is necessary and to maintain the safety of the travelling public and the workers.

The A6070 in both directions between the A6 roundabout and the roundabout at M6 junction 35. The closures will be from 8pm on:

North Road at the bridge where it crosses over the A6070. One footway/verge will remain open for pedestrian access. The actual closure dates are currently planned to occur:

These are the minimum durations we need to complete the works at Higher North Road Bridge and may be subject to change if problems are encountered. Any changes to the above dates will be advised on the website and on signs near the bridge.
